

Honors Program Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Science General Education Degree Requirements

Note: Courses in the major may be used to satisfy Honors Program support course requirements. This will not reduce the number of hours required for graduation, but gives opportunity for additional elective hours.

Honors **Bachelor of Music** students are required to take two Support Courses, one in each of two disciplines other than the arts. All other requirements remain the same.
