In cooperation with the Seneca County General Health District, the Stoner Health & Counseling Center will hold a COVID-19 vaccination clinic on campus on **Tuesday, November 30, from 1-3 p.m. in the Campus Center, Room 120.** 

Our goal is to offer a convenient option for those faculty, staff and students who wish to start or complete the vaccination process on campus, depending on the vaccine type you choose. We will be offering both the single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine and the FDA-approved Pfizer vaccine during this clinic.

Please note that if you choose the two-dose Pfizer vaccine, you would need to make arrangements for the second dose at your home (for students) or at a local vaccination site (for employees).

Vaccinations at the Health Center's clinic are by advance appointment only. If you would like to get your J&J vaccine or your first dose of the Pfizer vaccine at the clinic on November 30, please use this form to indicate your preferred time and vaccine type.
