

Measure 3: Teacher Licensure Exams (component R3.3)

As part of the process of becoming a licensed educator in particular areas in Ohio's pre-kindergarten through grade 12 system, candidates must pass licensure exams. Depending upon the content area, the tests for initial licensure are the Ohio Assessment for Educators, the ACTFL/LTI examinations for candidates who wish to teach world languages and Praxis assessments in selected areas. [Ohio Assessments for Educators \(OAE\)](#) measure professional, pedagogical and subject-specific knowledge and skills. Pearson's Evaluation Systems group provides these tests.
