



Heidelberg University holds student safety as a core value. One way in which our school commits to this value is by providing students with the proper training and knowledge to handle situations that may impact you or someone you know during your time in college. We want each student to have the knowledge and skills to be an active bystander, who intervenes when anyone is observed being harassed or endangered by sexual violence.

Being an active bystander doesn't stop at the edge of campus. For that reason, all students are required to complete the training. This includes students who are enrolled part-time, living off-campus, or those in online programs.

These two trainings will cover topics such as Consent & Sexual Violence, Bystander Intervention, Healthy Relationships, and Hazing & Bullying.

How to complete this training:

You will receive an email from our training partner, VECTOR, in the next few days. Simply follow the link in that email to begin the training. If you have not received the email, you can access your training account by logging into your Heidelberg Google account and clicking on this link: <https://heidelbergstudents-oh.safecolleges.com>.

The Sexual Violence Prevention training module is self-paced and will take around 61 minutes to complete.
