01 SMALL CLASSES

Heidelberg's average class size is 17. You'll make friends and get to know students with diverse backgrounds and interests.

It's nice to be a real person instead of a nameless face in a gigantic state university lecture hall. A small class environment gives you a better opportunity to ask questions, participate in discussions, and have a professor who actually knows who you are.

12 KNOW YOUR PROFESSORS

All Heidelberg classes are taught by professors. You'll also have two faculty mentors.

03 COLLABORATE WITH PROFESSORS

With either a small or nonexistent pool of graduate students, it's undergraduates who are selected to work with professors to can present their research at Heidelberg's annual Student Research Conference.
