Welcome to Heidelberg!

Move In Day is rapidly approaching and soon our Residence Life Staff will be on campus, preparing to welcome you to our residence halls. The Residence Life Staff wants to take a moment to offer some final reminders about making sure all of your housing items are completed.

Housing Application

If you have not already done so, be sure to visit your Housing Portal in [OASIS](#) to complete the New Student Housing Application. This form is required for you to be placed into housing, this includes preferences, meal plan and preferred building choices. We recommend taking your time when selecting your answers and that you rank each residence hall option as a first, second or third choice. Your answers on this application will be used in the roommate placement process!

Roommate Selection

Students wishing to be placed with a specific roommate will need to ensure that they have made themselves fully matched with their preferred roommate through the Housing Portal. By selecting "Room Selection - Roommates/Suitemates", you can search for your preferred roommate and select the student's name. Your preferred roommate will need to do the same. Names will show so long as the New Student Housing Application is completed. Your group is marked as FULLY MATCHED once successfully paired up with your preferred roommate. All roommate preferences must be made before July 1st.

Accommodation Needs

If you are in need of any type of housing accommodation for a disability or accessibility need, you must contact the [Office of Student Accessibility Services](#) and complete their paperwork prior to July 1st in order to fulfill the approved accommodation. While we will do everything we can to meet the needs of our students, after July 1st, we cannot guarantee that accommodations for housing options will be available.

Housing Placements

Housing Placements will be made during the first week of July. Students will receive an email confirmation of their housing placement and can view their placement and roommate information through their Housing Portal. Please note that in rare circumstances, sometimes your housing placement may change prior to you coming to campus. If this happens, you will be notified via email.



Commuter Students

If you plan to commute from home, you must complete and return the Commuter Housing Application and Good Neighbor Policy to the Office of Residence Life & Housing by August 1st. As a reminder, to qualify for Commuter Status, you must live at the primary residence of a Parent or Guardian and live within 35 miles of campus.
