

The Math Placement is now live in OASIS!

Please complete the assessment as soon as possible. For students in some majors, we will be unable to complete your Fall Schedule until we have the results from this assessment.

Take the assessment seriously. Your results can impact what courses you are eligible for this Fall, how many math and/or math-related courses you may have to complete to fulfill major requirements, and your long-term course sequencing.

A few notes:

- Heidelberg uses ALEKS for our math placement. ALEKS is an adaptive learning system that adjusts to your ability level based on initial information you provide and your answers to the presented questions. Be Honest and work through the assessment without assistance to ensure appropriate placement.
- You are able to stop and restart the assessment. If you do so, you will need to access the assessment through OASIS (not the ALEKS website) to restart.
- You have the ability to reassess if you are not satisfied with your results. However, there is a cool-off period of 72 hours between attempts and you must spend 5 hours in a learning module before you can reattempt.
- More information about the placement can be found on our <u>Math Placement FAQ</u> and we encourage you to read through this information prior to taking the placement.
