The [Owen Center for Academic and Career Support](#) is one of the places on campus that you will frequently visit. We offer several support services to students to help you succeed during your academic career at Heidelberg University. Below you will find information on each of the resources our office offers.

Academic Advising: All first year students are advised by an Advising Specialist in the Owen Center. The advisors will work with you throughout your first year at Heidelberg to ensure that you are in the appropriate courses for your intended major and work with you to help develop your academic and career goals. The advisors will be communicating with you via email and text throughout the summer.

Academic Support Services: We offer a diverse array of Academic Support services. Supplemental Instruction promotes student-centered learning through small-group study sessions, while Academic Coaching helps with the “nuts and bolts” of college success. Finally, our Writing Center provides individual writing assistance for all Heidelberg University classes.

Accessibility Services: Students with disabilities or other accessibility needs (allergies, chronic medical conditions, etc.) will find support, resources, and advocacy in identifying and ameliorating barriers to accessing their higher education.
