### What is the difference between hybrid and High Flex courses?

**Hybrid:** hybrid courses combine online and face-to-face delivery, in which some face-to-face meetings are completely replaced by online activities. Students who have a hybrid course will attend the seated course sessions some class days and work remotely on other class days. Hybrid courses are coded into Oasis with HY in the section column.

**Synchronous Online:** Synchronous online courses are remote courses with an established schedule of meetings. So, a synchronous online class that meets MWF at 11 requires students to “attend” class remotely every MWF at 11. Synchronous online courses are coded into Oasis with DS in the section column, have a scheduled meeting time, and list “ONLINE” as the class location.

**Asynchronous Online:** Asynchronous online courses are delivered entirely online without a set schedule of meetings. In asynchronous courses, students do not log on to Canvas to participate in the course at specific times, but rather log on and complete course

work based on their availability. Asynchronous online courses are coded into Oasis with DL in the section column, have TBA listed in the meeting time, and have TBA listed as the location.

**Mixed Online:** Mixed online courses are entirely online but use both synchronous and asynchronous elements. Mixed Online courses might ask students to log on for some synchronous meetings, and then complete the remaining course work asynchronously. Mixed online classes are coded into Oasis with DM in the section column, have a scheduled meeting time listed, and have TBA listed as the location.

**We noticed online that parents will need to take an online health screening before visiting the campus . . . are parents required to submit a request in order to visit the campus?**

No, but as you mention we are asking anyone who visits our campus to take an online screening and wear a face covering.

**Are parents (who are helping their child move into the Residence Halls) required to be tested as part of the Residence Life check-in process? If not, are parents allowed to enter the dormitory?**

Parents are not required to be tested.

2 people (in most cases parents) are allowed to help the student move items into the hall.

**Will clubs still be active for the Fall 2020 semester?**

The quick answer is yes clubs will be active. However, that activity will look different. Depending on the size of the group it may be asked to limit its in person gatherings. Some meetings or activities may be held virtually. Outdoors will be encouraged. But we will continue to work to engage our students in ways that promote either enjoyment and safety.

## **Will there be social activities planned on the weekends for the students to keep them engaged on campus?**

The quick answer is yes. However, in our COVID-19 world things will look differently. Activities will definitely take place but will be in smaller groups, virtually, or other safer modalities. The activities will adhere to physical distance and face covering. But it continues to be important to us to engage our students and enhance their Heidelberg experience.

## **What kind of test is the instant test we will be receiving on move in day, is it the nasal swab?**

Yes, the test is a nasal swab but the rapid is not the one that goes deep into the nasal cavity.

## **When students move back to campus will there be a limited number of people that are allowed to help them move in? Also, if the move in date that is given to them does not work for the family to get the student there how do we go about changing the move in date?**

1) Yes. We would like each student to arrive on campus with no more than 2 other people.

## **Since kids will be home the last 3 weeks of the semester, will there be a pro-rated discount on room and board for those 3 weeks?**

The price was set previously and we are following the university policy (and federal financial aid policy) regarding refunds of cost and aid. Once 60% of the semester is completed, students are no longer required to pay back any unused aid, and the university follows this rule with regard to tuition or housing refunds. Since the term on campus is beyond the 60% threshold, there will not be a refund, nor would students be required to return aid or loans that were awarded and used to cover room and board. If, however, the term were to be shortened to less than 60% of the time on campus, students would be refunded a prorated portion of their payments for room and board, as it was in spring term.
