If you would like to calculate the cost difference between your current costs (Option 1) by choosing the remote option (Option 2): Open up your current fee bill in Oasis. Enter any grant aid you receive into the box labeled state and federal grants. Enter any outside scholarships into the field for outside scholarships. Then enter any Heidelberg scholarships you receive and enter any University grant you receive in the corresponding box. If the amount of Heidelberg scholarship and/or University grant you receive causes your total aid to exceed the cost of tuition, the amount of that award will be deducted until you have no balance. This will be done on the order of University grant, then, if necessary, scholarship. These awards are reduced because they were originally calculated and awarded for a cost of attendance that included room and board.
